A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the April 11, 2022, Regular Board Meeting of the Winston Trails East Community Development District (the "District") to order at 6:38 p.m. in the Recreation Center located at 5980 Winston Trails Boulevard, Lake Worth, Florida 33463.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on October 1, 2021, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Pierman determined that the attendance of Chairman John Puleo, Vice Chairman Charles "Randy" Palo and Supervisors Van Schoen (via phone), Debra Barreiro and Pedro Raphael constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Also in attendance was District Manager Jason Pierman of Special District Services, Inc.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. November 8, 2021, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Pierman presented the minutes of the November 8, 2021, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any questions or comments.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Palo, seconded by Mr. Puleo and passed unanimously approving the proposal from AECOM in the amount of \$5,680 for the 20-Year Stormwater Report, as presented.

Mr. Pierman announced that the qualifying period is June 13th to the 17th, noting that Seats 4 and 5 (Mr. Schoen and Mr. Palo, respectively) are up for election this year. He also reminded the Board to submit their Form 1's.
