RE: Winston Trails (East) Community Development District Auditor Renewal

At the November 14, 2019 Winston Trails (East) Community Development District Board Of Supervisors meeting, the firm of Grau & Associates was selected to perform the 9-30-2019, 9-30-2020 and 9-30-2021 year end audits of the District with an option to perform the 9-30-2022 and 9-30-2023 audits.

The fees for the 9-30-2019 audit were \$3,200. The fees for the 9-30-2020 audit were \$3,300. And the fees for the 9-30-2021 audit were \$3,400. The proposed fees for the 9-30-2022 audit is \$3,500, which is the budgeted amount for audit fees for Fiscal Year 2022/2023. The proposed fee for the 9-30-23 audit is \$3,600.

Management is pleased with the professionalism and the competence of the Grau & Associates partners and staff; therefore, management recommends that the Board approve the renewal option for the Fiscal Year Ending 9-30-2022 and 9-30-2023 audits for Grau & Associates.
